EUROPEAN LANGUAGES DAY

Tuesday 26th September is European Languages Day. On the day, the children are invited to come into school dressed in the colours of their country's flag, face paint or a costume from that country. Your child will learn new language from the chosen country as well as do a range of fun activities.

The countries are as follows:

- **Reception** – United Kingdom (Red, White and Blue)
- **Year 1** – Spain (Red and Yellow)
- **Year 2** – France (Red, White and Blue)
- **Year 3** – Italy (Green, White and Red)
- **Year 4** – Germany (Black, Red and Yellow)
- **Year 5** – Denmark (Red and White)
- **Year 6** – Greece (Blue and White)

(Year 1, 2 and 5 can still wear the colours of the chosen flags but as it is PE Day, they MUST wear PE/Sports clothes)

MEET THE TEACHER 15.20 – 15.40

On **Tuesday (12th)** and **Thursday (14th)** next week there will be an opportunity to come into school and meet your child's class teacher, see their classroom and say hello to staff. Children will leave as usual on both evenings at 3.15pm. We will then re-open doors at 3.20pm to come into school with your child/children if you wish to. The events will be busy so we ask for your patience during entry as this will take time.

6C/6W - Entrance the children use to come into school from the junior playground

Pre-loved uniform will also be available if you are interested in the infant dining hall.
