TOWER POWER 2024 - THE ULTIMATE ECO TRIATHLON

Four members of our Eco-Squad sent Jordan Wylie MBE a good luck video message this week as he embarked on an amazing expedition.

Tower Power 2024 will see Jordan attempt to travel from the Leaning Tower of Pisa (Italy) to the Eiffel Tower (France) and finish at Blackpool Tower (UK). The expedition will be an adventure experiment that he will complete in the most sustainable way possible. He is using a bike made from coppiced wood, a kayak made from recycled plastic bottles. He will be wild camping and eating locally sourced food. He will be wearing recycled clothing and using recycled equipment. Jordan is raising money for the Army Cadet Charitable Trust (ACCT) and is also donating money raised towards a very special project in memory of Jordan Banks, one of our pupils who tragically had his life cut short in May 2021. We will be following Jordan's progress and hope he raises as much money as possible.







Operation Encompass now operates throughout Lancashire police force. It helps police and schools work together to provide emotional and practical help to children. The system ensures that when police are called to an incident of domestic abuse, where there are children in the household who have experienced the domestic incident, the police will inform the school (Miss Manson) before the child or children arrive the following day. This ensures that the school has up to date relevant information about the child's circumstances and can enable support to be given to the child.
